Rules for Entry

- 1. To enter, you must be between 5 and 12 years of age on 20thth December 2017 and you must be resident in the United Kingdom
- 2. You should print the following information (IN BLOCK CAPITALS) on the back of each entry:
 - Name, school, class
 - Signature of your teacher, parent or guardian (please note that one signature from a teacher will be sufficient to cover all entries from a school).
- 3. You may enter one piece of artwork only. Only individual entries will be accepted.
- 4. Your entry should be submitted in flat format, A4 in size.
- 5. Use of Materials: You may use any type of paper, white, coloured, rough or smooth. The work that you submit may be drawn or painted in pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, crayon, pastel, watercolour, gouache, acrylics, oils, poster colour and collage.
- 6. Originality. Your work should be original and unaided. Please do not copy another person's work. Framed entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 7. The closing date for entries to the Competition is Wednesday 20th December 2017. This date is final. If your entry is received after this date it will not be submitted to the judges.
- 8. The organisers take no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of entry is not proof of receipt.
- 9. The Judging Panel is responsible for the allocation of prizes and the decision of the Judging Panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding that decision.
- 10. All entries shall be the property of A H Proctor (author), who shall also be the owner of the copyright. AH Proctor will not accept liability for loss or damage to any work submitted and by entering the competition you hereby assign all copyright and other intellectual property rights may have in your entry to A H Proctor and you waive all moral rights in your entry
- 11. All entries together with the artists' details (name, age, school or town) may be used in publicity campaigns for this year's Competition and for future Competitions. Photographs of the winners together with their names and ages may be used in publicity campaigns where the parents or guardians of the winners have given their consent.
- 12. The rules of the Competition may not be changed or modified and will strictly be applied.
- 13. All personal information supplied will be used solely for the administration of the Budding Illustrator's Competition.
- 14. There will be 1 winner chosen by the judges
- 15. The winner's prize is the recreation of their illustration in the fourth book in the Thumble Tumble book series.
- 16. The prize winner and runners up will be announced in January 2018.
- 17. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and is not redeemable for cash or other prizes.
- 18. The organisers reserve the right to change the prize at its discretion or to offer an alternative or similar prize in the event the original prize offered is not available for reasons outside the organiser reasonable control
- 19. Awards Ceremony: the winner of the competition along with the 6 runners up will be invited to attend an awards ceremony which will be held in Glasgow Hunterian Museum
